He has been a prominent commentator on the *Stern Report*, and he was a key member of the 2006 UK House of Lords Economics Committee *Report into the Economics of Climate Change*. The report remains the most comprehensive investigation into climate change and its economic consequences.

Lord Lawson was a key proponent of the Thatcher Government's privatisation and tax reform programme.

In this lecture, he will examine the policy responses to climate change.
